What is eSight?

They are worn comfortably like a normal pair of glasses. eSight is the only clinically validated device, in existence, that enables those living with vision loss to see, be mobile, and engage in virtually any Activity of Daily Living. This enables true mobility. eSight's remote allows visually impaired wearers to control everything - zoom (up to 24 times), contrast, focus, even taking photos and streaming content directly to their eSight.
