## Rasheda

**Industry:** Risk management

**Condition:** Retinitis pigmentosa

Before getting an eSight, Rasheda managed at work with two technologies: zoom text and a specialized computer monitor with a high contrast screen. These devices slowed down her computer. Not to mention, she still had to sit close to the screen, which was hurting her back. With eSight, she went from 20/200 vision acuity to 20/20. No longer using the assistive technology that was slowing her down, Rasheda takes advantage of the device's patented bioptic tilt, zoom and contrast features. In doing so, Rasheda has reduced eye strain and eliminated back pain caused by poor ergonomics, which she believes has added years to her career.

## Shane

**Industry:** Communications

**Condition:** Retinopathy of prematurity

Shane works at three local radio stations, doing voice and commercial recordings. Having grown up with limited vision, he was accustomed to not using any assistive technologies. Before eSight, he tried using screen magnifiers, but the results were not ideal. Using eSight's zoom, contrast and magnification features, Shane is able to see near and far. He's also been able to take on extra responsibilities, making him more productive at work.

**Condition:** Cone rod dystrophy

Irving's eye condition did not affect his career until he reached his 50s, at which time he started to struggle with reading the computer. He tried various assistive devices but none of them worked. He was reaching a point where he was considering early retirement or a job change. After discovering eSight, Irving was able to take on additional responsibilities. He can now view and participate more in presentations and review key documents. He commonly uses zoom and autofocus features and occasionally will use the grayscale contrast mode for specific tasks. Irving shares that eSight has given him the freedom to do the things he loves.

## Mark

**Industry:** Fast-food restaurant management

**Condition:** Nystagmus

Growing up with limited vision, Mark did well without the use of technology, only occasionally using handheld magnifiers or smartphones. After trying eSight, he saw how much more he could do while using the device. Mark's job is fast-paced and requires the use of his hands. Given the hands-free nature of eSight, he can now read the boards while continuing to use his hands to create sandwiches. He even jokes that he is now the fastest sandwich maker in his restaurant.

# Zara Ghandi

**Grade 4**

**Condition:** Leber's Congenital Amaurosis (LCA)

Zara learned how to use eSight in less than no time. Currently in elementary school, Zara uses her device to see the board in class. She also uses the built-in camera to record and take pictures, allowing her to review class activities or handouts at a later time if she chooses. Given her eye condition and significant loss of peripheral vision, Zara was unable to see in low light settings and fully gauge her surroundings. With eSight, she is able to go for walks when it starts to get dark. This is a great comfort for her parents. Zara is also starting to participate in low impact sports thanks to her eSight.

# Austin Pearson

**Grade 10**

**Condition:** Nystagmus

Originally an eSight 3 user, Austin finds that eSight 4's improvement with contrast and grayscale make a big difference. At school, Austin can see the whiteboard without special seating accommodations. He finds the eSight 4 halo comfort band, the easy to change rechargeable batteries, and the significantly improved ventilation allow him to enjoy the benefits of enhanced vision for more of the day. **Condition:** Retinopathy of prematurity and Glaucoma

Prior to using eSight, Tannous used stationary assistive technology and software programs like Adobe Acrobat at school. At home, her parents would assist with homework as she found it difficult to see the assignments. With eSight she's able to see the board clearly, read her textbooks and easily read sheet music when she plays her clarinet. Specifically, she enjoys using the zoom, freeze and contrast features regularly in class. The ability to mirror her computer screen to her device is extremely helpful for Tannous. And she loves that she can retain 100% of her mobility. Tannous is looking forward to studying Information Technology and is confident that eSight will be very beneficial for her future.

# Rosa Henderson

**College (Business Administration and Management)**

**Condition:** Unkown cause of legal blindness

Before using eSight, Rosa had to sit 3 feet away from the whiteboard and print materials ahead of each class. She also had to audio record her lectures. However, visual-centric courses like math proved to be difficult to follow when solely using audio prompts. With eSight, she can sit wherever she wants and can take pictures, record and zoom in if she needs to. In doing so, she no longer has to print off materials out of necessity and can follow lectures like math without any difficulty. Not to mention, with her eSight, she can present in class and see the expressions of her peers, further connecting with them.
